**Guidelines for Authors** 

Submissions should be prepared utilizing a style commonly acceptable to the author's field or discipline. The following particulars should be carefully observed.

Format of articles: Author(s), Institution(s), Title. A second abstract in English is requested for articles not written in English.

Use double-spacing throughout.

Manuscripts cannot be returned. Please submit 2 copies plus a CD.

Use double quotation marks for material written by other authors; to indicate titles of journal articles, chapters in books.

Use single quotation marks for glosses of non-English words.

Put all quotation marks inside following punctuation.

Cited forms should be italicized. With computer, use italics instead of underscoring.

With typewriter, single underlines for italics, double underline for small caps. Type on one side of paper only.

Single space after period.

Use a comma after e.g., i.e., viz.,

Avoid indenting paragraphs.

Titles of books and journals are in italics. Use a colon between the volume number of a journal and pages (e.g., 5:19-25).

Format of reviews: Author(s). Date. Title (italicized). Series, if any (roman). Place of publication: Publisher. Pages (e.g., xi + 255).
